

Use this Pagination diagram to make notes and keep track of pages as you design your album.

Acrylic Cover Album

Each Acrylic Cover Album begins with a single page on the right that shows through as the cover. This cover page is an extra page in the album and does not count as one of the pages in the album. For example a 10 page (20 sides) album will have 21 sides total, counting the one image for the cover. Turning the cover page, opens to a double page spread with a photograph on the left and on the right. The album continues that way to the end.

Albums are listed by the number of pages they contain. Be sure to note that each page has two sides, so an album will hold twice as many photographs (sometimes referred to as sides) as it has pages. For example, a 10 page book will hold 20 photographs plus one for the cover.
